2025 Fantasy Draft Tournament Rules

The Fantasy Draft tournament is designed to level the playing field between teams. All levels of scratch bowlers are encouraged to sign up. Individual bowlers will sign up to be DRAFTED by MA USBC Hall of Fame Members and other Top-Notch Milwaukee Area Bowlers. Teams will consist of one captain and other draftees from the pool of entrants. Teams will consist of four or five member teams based on entries.

Eligibility

- a. The tournament is open to all Adult Milwaukee Area USBC (MA USBC) and Hall of Fame members. If not a member of the MA USBC, a membership must be purchased, prior to entry, of 1 of the following
 - i. Full Membership \$25
 - ii. Local only membership \$10 (current full membership must be in place with another association)

Entering Average

a. Bowler must have a minimum of 190 average to enter

3. Players and Substitutes

- a. A substitute because of an injury, no show, or illness can be used at the tournament director's discretion and conjunction with approval from the team captains
- b. In the event a spot cannot be filled, the tournament director will randomly draw an entrant from the same draft round and those scores will be used for the team. If both teams make the cut the team that is short a bowler will get the highest bowler from that draft round that is not in the finals.

4. Format

- a. Bowlers will bowl 4 games on the same pair of lanes for the qualifying block
- b. The top eight (8) teams will advance to the elimination and bowl baker system matches
- c. Teams will bowl two (2) baker games in a bracket format with the highest total score advancing (based on 24 teams, format may be adjusted with fewer entries)
- Teams will bowl each game on one lane and switch lanes for the second game.
- e. The order of bowlers may be changed at the start of each game.
- f. In Baker, each player will bowl a frame, except for the 10th frame. The #2 bowler throws the first ball in the 10th. If bowler #2 leaves one or more pins and picks up the spare, bowler #3 rolls the fill ball in the 10th. If bowlers #2 and #3 strike, then bowler #4 throws the fill ball. If bowler #3 leaves one or more pins the #4 bowler will cover the spare. If 5 person teams each bowler will bowl two frames.
- g. Participants must report all score corrections at the time of bowling or the score stands.
- h. Lanes will not be re-oiled prior to the Baker matches. Tournament pattern will NOT be sport compliant and be a modified house pattern.
- i. If teams tie in the Baker two game matches an additional Baker game will be bowled. If still tied, the teams will bowl as many 9th & 10th frames needed to determine a winner.
- j. Team ties in qualifying will be broken by high team game in qualifying.
- k. All other USBC rules apply; in the event of a dispute tournament director has final say to resolve conflict.

5. Tournament Operations

- a. Re-racking will be permitted only with the express approval of a tournament official. Any re-rack without approval will result in a zero (0) score for that frame.
- b. All bowlers must meet eligibility listed above which will be subject to verification.
- c. All competition will be on a scratch basis.

6. Draft Procedure

- a. Captains will randomly draw for 1st Round order, Round 2 will draft in the reverse order, last to first. Round 3 will be a randomized draft order. Captains will have one minute for each selection.
- b. Previous Captains include Steve Brinkman, Glen Deutchendorf, Todd Drouillard, Ken Duffield, Eric Fritton, Kyle Geurtsen, Chris Hill, Chad Kloss, Scott Helm, Chad Maas, Jim Miller Jr, Craig Mueller, Rich Mueller, Chris Pierson, Hank Posnanski Jr, Jeff Selec, Ron Wallenkamp Jr, Scott Weiland, William Welch and Gus Yannaras.

7. Prize Fund

- a. 100% prize fund returned
- b. Prizes will be paid to all teams in the baker finals

Tournament Schedule

a. 9:00 am Captains Begin Draft

b. 10:30 am Qualifying

c. 2:30 pm Baker Finals (Approximate time)

d. All bowlers should be ready to bowl by 10:30 am.

9. Entry Fees

- a. Entries must be accompanied by the full amount of fees to secure a spot and shall be in the association office by December 31, 2024 at 5:00 pm.
- b. If your entry is withdrawn after December 31, 2024 and a replacement can not be found, you will forfeit your entry fee. If a replacement can be found, you will get refunded your entry minus \$20 to go to that year's charity.
- Fees can be made via check, cash or credit card.
- d. Entry fees consist of:
 - i. Prize Fee \$50.00
 - ii. Expense Fee \$10.00
