24-25 Senior/Non-Senior Doubles Handicap Tournament - Rules Certification # 4676

1. ELIGIBILITY

- a. The tournament is open to all adult Milwaukee Area USBC (MA USBC) members. Bowlers must have 21+ games (all games must be in the same league) in the previous season or 12+ games (all games must be in the same league) in the current season of a certified MA USBC league. MA USBC Hall of Fame members are also eligible.
- b. Teams may consist of a maximum of 1 certified bowler that is not a member of the MA USBC.
 - i. If not a member of the MA USBC, a membership must be purchased, prior to entry
 - 1. Full membership \$25
 - 2. Local only membership \$10 (current full membership must be in place with USBC)
- c. Each team must consist of 1 bowler 50+ years of age, and 1 bowler under 50 years of age
- d. Bowler may participate a maximum of 3 times, and must change 1 bowler with each entry
- e. This tournament is certified by the USBC, and all USBC tournament rules will apply

2. ENTERING AVERAGE

- a. Leagues designated as Sport/Challenge will be adjusted using the USBC average adjustment scale, if it is the only average available (USBC Rule 201c)
- b. Bowlers must report any rerated/adjusted average from any other tournament or association
- c. Averages used for tournament eligibility apply in this order
 - i. Highest USBC league average
 - 1. 2023-2024 winter season for 21 or more games
 - 2. 2023-2024 summer season for 21 or more games
 - 3. 2024-2025 winter season average for 21 or more games
 - ii. If no average, bowler will use a 230 average
 - iii. If the current average (21 games or more) is 15 or more pins higher than the entering average, the current average must be used at the time of bowling the 1st event
- d. It shall be the bowlers responsibility to verify the accuracy of their average, whether originally submitted by the bowler, the team captain, or others. Failure to use the proper average or make a correction prior to the completion of the first game of a series, shall disqualify the score if the submitted average is lower than the actual average (USBC Rule 319a-3)
- e. As a condition of entry, a bowler who has won a cash and/or merchandise prize of \$300 or more in any event; total combined prize winnings of \$500 or more in any one tournament, or total combined prize winnings of \$1000 or more in all tournaments within the last 12 month period, MUST, AT TIME OF ENTRY, REPORT their actual score, position and amount won. Bowlers are cautioned to be aware of the average adjustment requirements of USBC Rule 319e. (USBC Rule 319)

3. FORMAT

- a. Bowlers will bowl 3 games on the same pair of lanes
- b. Handicap will be
- i. 90% of 460
- c. Team shall be classified as handicap in 1 division

4. CASH PRIZE LIST

- a. All prize money will be returned 100%
- b. A cash prize list will be based on at least 1 in 5 ratio in all divisions

5. ENTRY FEES

- a. Entries must be accompanied by the full amount of fees
 - i. On site payments will be assessed a \$10 convenience fee
- b. Fees can be made via credit card, Venmo, Zelle, PayPal, CashApp, check, or cash
- c. Entry fees consist of:
 - i. Prize Fee \$19.50
 - ii. Bowling Fee \$12.00
 - iii. Expense Fee \$3.50
- d. Optional scratch fees consist of (both bowlers must enter this option)
