24-25 Women's Championship Tournament Rules (Certification #5757)

1. ELIGIBILITY

- a. The tournament is open to all adult women Milwaukee Area USBC (MA USBC) members. Bowlers must have 21+ games (all games must be in the same league) in the previous season or 12+ games (all games must be in the same league) in the current season of a certified MA USBC league. MA USBC Hall of Fame members are also eligible.
- Teams may consist of a maximum of 1 certified bowler that is not a member of the MA USBC.
 - i. If not a member of the MA USBC, a membership must be purchased, prior to entry
 - 1. Full membership \$25
 - 2. Local only membership \$10 (current full membership must be in place with USBC)
- c. The number of bowlers classified as PROFESSIONAL BOWLERS is limited to NOT more than 2 such bowlers on a 4 person team and NOT more than 1 such bowler in a doubles pair. Such professionals are identified as and include "Standard" and "Full", National Regional, Senior and Residential professionals.
- d. Bowlers are permitted to bowl only 1 time in a Doubles/Singles event regardless of division. Bowlers may bowl a maximum of 3 times in the team event, regardless of division, provided that at least 2 bowlers change on the team roster.
- e. The 1st series in the team event will count towards the bowler's all events.
- f. Substitutes must meet the eligibility requirements.
- Pacers are not allowed.
- This tournament is certified by the USBC, and all USBC tournament rules will apply

2. ENTERING AVERAGE

- Leagues designated as Sport/Challenge will be adjusted using the USBC average adjustment scale, if it is the only average available (USBC Rule 201c)
- b. Bowlers must report any rerated/adjusted average from any other tournament or association
- c. Averages used for tournament eligibility apply in this order
 - Highest USBC league average
 - 1. 2023-2024 winter season for 21 or more games
 - 2. 2023-2024 summer season for 21 or more games
 - 2024-2025 winter season average for 21 or more games
 - ii. If no average, bowler will use a 220 average
 - iii. If the current average (21 games or more) is 15 or more pins higher than the entering average, the current average must be used at the time of bowling the 1st event
- d. It shall be the bowlers responsibility to verify the accuracy of their average, whether originally submitted by the bowler, the team captain, or others. Failure to use the proper average or make a correction prior to the completion of the first game of a series, shall disqualify the score if the submitted average is lower than the actual average (USBC Rule 319a-3)
- e. As a condition of entry, a bowler who has won a cash and/or merchandise prize of \$300 or more in any event; total combined prize winnings of \$500 or more in any one tournament, or total combined prize winnings of \$1000 or more in all tournaments within the last 12 month period, MUST, AT TIME OF ENTRY, REPORT their actual score, position and amount won. Bowlers are cautioned to be aware of the average adjustment requirements of USBC Rule 319e. (USBC Rule 319)
- f. Tournament management reserves the right to adjust an entrant's average. If the adjustment is refused, entry fee will be refunded and the bowler will not bowl the event. (USBC Rule 319c).
- g. Bowlers must report all score corrections within 72 hours or scores stand (USBC Rule 327b).

3. FORMAT

- a. Bowlers will bowl as follows:
 - Team Event Bowl 3 games on the same pair of lanes
 - ii. Doubles & Singles Event Bowl 6 games on the same pair of lanes
- b. Handicap will be 100% based on the bowlers assigned division
 - Team

i.

- 1. Division 1 Combined average of 651 & over (handicap based on combined average of 880)
- 2. Division 2 Combined average of 595 to 650 (handicap based on combined average of 650)
- 3. Division 3 Combined average of 594 & under (handicap based on combined average of 594)
- ii. Doubles
 - 1. Division 1 Combined average of 328 & over (handicap based on combined average of 440)
 - 2. Division 2 Combined average of 296 to 327 (handicap based on combined average of 327)
 - 3. Division 3 Combined average of 295 & under (handicap based on combined average of 295)
- iii. Singles & All Events
 - 1. Division 1 Average of 169 & over (handicap based on average of 220)
 - 2. Division 2 Average of 148 to 168 (handicap based on average of 168)
 - Division 3 Average of 147 & under (handicap based on average of 147)
- iv. Scratch Option
 - Division 1 Scratch

4. AWARDS AND PRIZE LIST

- a. All prize money will be returned 100%
- b. Awards will be given to the 1st place winners in each team division. Awards will be given to the 1st place handicap winners in each doubles, singles, and all events division, as well as overall scratch winners in these 3 events. Winners of multiple categories receive only 1 award (there are no awards for the optional scratch events).
- c. A cash prize list will be based on the following:
 - i. Team, Doubles & Singles Event at least 1 in 5 ratio
 - All Events & Optional Scratch Events at least 1 in 5 ratio

ii. 5. ENTRY FEES

- Entries must be accompanied by the full amount of fees
- b. On site payments will be assessed a \$10 convenience fee
- c. Fees can be made via credit card, Venmo, Zelle, PayPal, CashApp, check, or cash
- d Entry fees consist of
 - i. Handicap Prize Fee \$14.00; Scratch Option Prize Fee \$11.00; Bowling Fee \$12.00 per 3 game set; Expense Fee \$3.00; scratch expense fee \$1.00

6. STANDARD TOURNAMENT ITEMS

- a. Entries close March 30, 2025, unless extended. The association reserves the right to extend the closing date. Additional squads may be added during the course of the tournament as deemed necessary by the tournament management.
- b. All winners must meet eligibility and average requirements listed above and will be subject to verification.
- c. Maximum number of bowlers per lane is 4 for Team and 3 for Doubles & Singles.
- d. Maximum individual handicap score may not exceed 300
- e. Maximum individual handicap series may not exceed 900
