24-25 Youth Championship Tournament Rules (Certification #05404)

ELIGIBILITY

- The tournament is open to all youth Milwaukee Area USBC (MA USBC) members. Bowlers must have 21+ games (all games must be in the same league) in the previous season or 12+ games (all games must be in the same league) in the current season of a certified MA USBC league
- Teams may consist of a maximum of 1 certified bowler that is not a member of the MA USBC.
 - If not a member of the MA USBC, a membership must be purchased, prior to entry
 - Youth & Collegiate Membership \$4
- Bowlers are permitted to bowl only 1 time in a Doubles/Singles event regardless of division. Bowlers may bowl a maximum of 3 times in the team event, regardless of division, provided that at least 2 bowlers change on the team roster.
 - This tournament is certified by the USBC, and all USBC tournament rules will apply

ENTERING AVERAGE

- Leagues designated as Sport/Challenge will be adjusted using the USBC average adjustment scale, if it is the only average available (USBC Rule 201c)
- Bowlers must report any rerated/adjusted average from any other tournament or association
- Averages used for tournament eligibility apply in this order
 - Highest USBC league average
 - As of December 1, 2024 for 21 or more games
 - 2023-2024 winter season for 21 or more games
 - ii. If no average, bowler will use a 230 average
 - iii. If the current average (21 games or more) is 15 or more pins higher than the entering average, the current average must be used at the time of bowling the 1st event
- It shall be the coach's responsibility to verify the accuracy of the bowler's average, whether originally submitted by the bowler, the team captain, or others. Failure to use the proper average or make a correction prior to the completion of the first game of a series, shall disqualify the score if the submitted average is lower than the actual average (USBC Rule 319a-3)
- Entry must be accompanied by the December 1, 2024 league standing sheet.
- Tournament management reserves the right to adjust an entrant's average. If the adjustment is refused, entry fee will be refunded and the bowler will not bowl the event.(USBC Rule 319c).
- Bowlers must report all score corrections within 72 hours or scores stand (USBC Rule 327b).

FORMAT

- Bowlers will bowl as follows: a.
 - Team Event Bowl 3 games on the same pair of lanes i
 - Doubles & Singles Event Bowl 6 games on the same pair of lanes ii.
- Handicap will be 100% based on the bowlers assigned division

SCHOLARSHIP PRIZE LIST

- All prize money will be returned 100%
- A Scholarship prize list will be based on at least 1 in 4 ratio in all divisions
 - Milwaukee Area USBC will add \$5 per entrant per event to the scholarship prize fund

ENTRY FEES

- Entries must be accompanied by the full amount of fees
- On site payments will be assessed a \$10 convenience fee
- Fees can be made via credit card, Venmo, Zelle, PayPal, CashApp, check, or cash
- Entry fees consist of:
 - Prize Fee \$8.00 per 3 game set
 - Bowling Fee \$12.00 per 3 game set

STANDARD TOURNAMENT ITEMS

- Appropriate attire must be worn
 - No caps or headgear permitted without prior permission of tournament director
- All Events entry fee must be received prior to bowling the first event
- The association reserves the right to extend the closing date. Additional squads may be added during the course of the tournament as deemed necessary by the tournament management.
- All winners must meet eligibility and average requirements listed above and will be subject to verification.
- Entries close January 26, 2025, unless extended.
- Maximum number of bowlers per lane is 4 for Team and 3 for Doubles & Singles. f.
- Maximum individual handicap score may not exceed 300
- Maximum individual handicap series may not exceed 900
