24-25 Youth Singles Scholarship Tournament Rules Certification # 6412

1. ELIGIBILITY

- a. The tournament is open to all youth Milwaukee Area USBC (MA USBC) members. Youth bowlers must have 21+ games (all games must be in the same league) in the previous season or 12+ games (all games must be in the same league) in the current season of a certified MA USBC league.
- b. If not a member of the MA USBC, a membership must be purchased, prior to entry
 - i. Youth & Collegiate Membership \$4
- c. This tournament is certified by the USBC, and all USBC tournament rules will apply

2. ENTERING AVERAGE

- a. Bowlers must report any rerated/adjusted average from any other tournament or association
- b. Averages used for tournament eligibility apply in this order
 - i. Highest USBC league average
 - 1. 2023-2024 winter season for 21 or more games
 - 2. As of December 1, 2024 for 21 or more games
 - ii. If no average, bowler will use a 230 average
 - iii. If the current average (12 games or more) is 15 or more pins higher than the entering average, the current average must be used at the time of bowling the 1st event
- c. It shall be the bowlers responsibility to verify the accuracy of their average, whether originally submitted by the bowler, the team captain, or others. Failure to use the proper average or make a correction prior to the completion of the first game of a series, shall disqualify the score if the submitted average is lower than the actual average (USBC Rule 319a-3)
- d. As a condition of entry, a bowler who has won a cash and/or merchandise prize of \$300 or more in any event; total combined prize winnings of \$500 or more in any one tournament, or total combined prize winnings of \$1000 or more in all tournaments within the last 12 month period, MUST, AT TIME OF ENTRY, REPORT their actual score, position and amount won. Bowlers are cautioned to be aware of the average adjustment requirements of USBC Rule 319e. (USBC Rule 319)

3. FORMAT

- a. Bowlers will bowl 3 games on the same pair of lanes
- b. Handicap will be 100% based on the bowlers assigned division
 - i. Bovs
 - 1. Division 1 Average of 186 & over Scratch
 - 2. Division 2 Average of 161 to 185 (handicap based on average of 185)
 - 3. Division 3 Average of 131 to 160 (handicap based on average of 160)
 - 4. Division 4 Average of 101 to 130 (handicap based on average of 130)
 - 5. Division 5 Average of 100 & under (handicap based on average of 100)
 - ii. Girls
 - 1. Division 1 Average of 165 & over Scratch
 - 2. Division 2 Average of 143 to 164 (handicap based on average of 164)
 - 3. Division 3 Average of 122 to 142 (handicap based on average of 142)
 - 4. Division 4 Average of 101 to 121 (handicap based on average of 121)
 - 5. Division 5 Average of 100 & under (handicap based on average of 100)

4. SCHOLARSHIP PRIZE LIST

- a. All prize money will be returned 100%
- b. A Scholarship prize list will be based on at least 1 in 4 ratio in all divisions
- c. Milwaukee Area USBC will add \$25 per entrant to the scholarship prize fund

5. ENTRY FEES

- a. Entries must be accompanied by the full amount of fees
 - On site payments will be assessed a \$10 convenience fee
- b. Fees can be made via credit card, Venmo, Zelle, PayPal, CashApp, check, or cash
- c. Entry fees consist of:
 - i. Prize Fee \$25.00
 - ii. Bowling Fee \$12.00
 - iii. Expense Fee \$3.00

6. STANDARD TOURNAMENT ITEMS

- a. Entries close December 29, 2024 unless extended.
- b. Maximum number of bowlers per lane is 4.
- c. Maximum individual handicap score may not exceed 300
- d. Maximum individual handicap series may not exceed 900
