 - Youth & Collegiate Membership \$4 iii.
 - Each team must consist of 1 Adult bowler and 1 Youth bowler
- This tournament is certified by the USBC, and all USBC tournament rules will apply d.

- a. Bowlers must report any rerated/adjusted average from any other tournament or association
